RE: State Credentialing System (CIS)

Effective January 1, 2008, the state of North Carolina Office of EMS (NCOEMS) will no longer accept any blue bubble sheets for exam scheduling, recredentialing, or registering for EMS Classes. You will also no longer be able to register for exams using the voice response system

You **must** register with the Community College in order to take classes. In addition, once the class begins, you will be given a registration code and **you will be responsible** to register with NCOEMS by the CIS system for the class. At the end of the course, the course instructor will grade your completion with the state and then **YOU** will schedule your own exam date. This new process will be the responsibility of the individual EMS Provider.

If you hold a credential at this time, NCOEMS has issued you a "P" number. This number is assigned to you and is how you will log on to the CIS system. Your agency should be able to provide your P number to you. If not we will work with providers to get your P numbers to assist in this transition time.

To log onto CIS you need to go to the following website:

- 1. http://www.emspic.org/cis.html
- 2. Then click on "Click here to log on to CIS"
- A new window should pop up with a log on screen asking for your P number and password.
- 4. Your user ID is your "P" number
- 5. Password is your social security number with no dashes or spaces.
- 6. Once you are logged on you will have to edit your profile and establish a new password. You will also be directed to a screen for user agreement. You will electronically sign with your new password.
- 7. From this site you will register for any classes (EMT-I, EMT-P, or Continuing Education Program) or state exams.
